COLLECT

The Passion – Mark 15: 1-39

Congregational Parts

*The passion is read in parts, with four places
where the congregation joins in.*

Prompt 1 (Pilate) - Then what do you wish me
to do with the man you call the King of the
Jews?

Crowd – **Crucify him!**

Pilot – Why, what evil has he done?

Crowd (louder) – **Crucify him!**

Prompt 2 (Evangelist) - And they clothed him
in a purple cloak; and after twisting some
thorns into a crown, they put it on him. And
they began saluting him,
Soldiers – **Hail, King of the Jews!**

Prompt 3 (Evangelist) - ...And with him they
crucified two bandits, one on his right and
one on his left. Those who passed by derided
him, shaking their heads.

Passers-by – **Aha! You who would destroy
the temple and build it in three days, save
yourself, and come down from the cross!**

Prompt 4 (Evangelist) - which means “My
God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”
When some of the bystanders heard it they
said,

Bystanders – **Listen, he is calling for Elijah.**
